RECOGNITION AND PROTECTION FOR GUILDFORD



The potential heritage listing of Guildford is on track. From the week of November 20 the City of Swan will be sending a survey form to every resident asking whether you think the town should be heritage listed, in a way similar to the heritage precinct of the west end of Fremantle. The survey will include an information pack and the opportunity to ask follow-up questions.



Two public meetings coming up will provide information and the chance to find out more before you respond to the survey. Please come along and ensure your voice is heard.

On Saturday November 18 at 1pm in St Matthew's Church Hall at Stirling Square the Member for Midland Hon Michelle Roberts is conducting a Guildford Heritage

Forum with Heritage Minister Hon David Templeman as keynote speaker.



At the next **GA meeting on Tuesday November 21 at 7.30pm in the Mechanics Institute** in Meadow Street, Guildford (next to Post Office) representatives from the City of Swan and the Heritage Council of WA will be attending to speak about heritage listing. All welcome!

The GA has long campaigned for state heritage listing for Guildford to protect the historic town for future generations.

State Heritage Listing should:

* Recognise Guildford Town as a rare and unique historic town in WA and Australia

* Protect historic Guildford town for future generations

* Not require you to alter your property or prevent additional developments consistent with current policies

* Maintain or increase Guildford's residential property values

* Provide greater planning certainty for all property owners

* Ensure future development/Ministerial decisions in the town are consistent with the existing City of Swan Guildford Conservation Precinct Policy



MCDONALDS UPDATE

GA representatives recently attended a directions hearing of the State Administrative Tribunal (SAT), where McDonalds is appealing the Joint Development Assessment Panel (JDAP) decision to reject their application to build a fast-food outlet in the carpark of the Guildford Hotel. The SAT hearing is this Friday November 17 and the GA will be making a written response. The mediation is between McDonalds and the presiding member of the JDAP panel, supported by the State Solicitors Office.
