\$100,000 TOURISM BOOST FOR GUILDFORD

The Guildford Association is very appreciative of the Labor Party's election promise of \$100,000 to boost tourism in Guildford.

The commitment came about following the recent release of the findings of the Guildford Tourism Forum, which was hosted by our local member Michelle Roberts (pictured below second from right launching the document). The Guildford Tourism Forum in 2015 was

attended by now Premier Mark McGowan.

All sides of politics were invited to attend and have input into the community forum.

The new State Government has allocated one hundred thousand dollars for tourism projects and infrastructure in Guildford. This funding commitment will make it possible for the GA to promote Guildford through a range of infrastructure projects including signage, artwork and cultural displays.



An electronic copy of the report has been sent to all members and there is a hard copy in Guildford Library. Thanks to all those who attended the forum and contributed their ideas.
